Online Course Requirements

Students who register for an on-line class must have access to a computer which will support the instructional materials. The online platform is the Moodle system. Students should plan to devote a minimum of five or six hours per week to each online course. A critical component of each online course involves active participation in the virtual classroom to include the threaded discussions. Online courses do not meet in person. Students work independently, completing internet based reading assignments and communicating

with instructors and other students by email inside the Moodle classroom platform. Weekly homework assignments are also submitted online inside the classroom.

Registration and Book Ordering Procedures

Residential Students

- Complete registration two weeks before classes start.
- Schedule an appointment with your Academic Advisor and decide on your quarter schedule. Forms must have your advisor's signature.
- Fill out the registration form completely including current address, phone numbers and email address.
- Please note that all class schedules and the registration forms are also available at www.stratford.edu in the Current Students section.
- Schedule an appointment with financial aid and/or business offices to pay fees and obtain signatures on the registration form. I-20 students must also obtain a signature from the International Student Advisor.
- The white copy of the registration will be processed by the registrar's office.

Online Students

- Consult with the program advisor through email or chat to select appropriate courses.
- Use the on-line registration to select classes.
- Registrations will be reviewed by the Financial Aid and Business Office prior to final processing.
- The registrar's office will send a copy of completed registration after approval from all offices.

ONLINE Classes -- The online website platform is located at <http://moodle.stratford.edu>. If you have registered for a Stratford University Online course, you can access your class at this URL. To log in, please enter your User ID and password in the appropriate spaces. You will be issued your email, username, ID and password after you register for the class (continuing students use their current account information). Your username and password will be sent to you by e-mail by IT helpdesk. If you have not received your credentials after the start of your classes, contact IT Helpdesk immediately (helpdesk@startford.edu)

Textbook Ordering Procedures

- Students are expected to have textbooks the first day of class; copying of another student's book is copyright infringement.

 - Access Current Student; Click Order Books, Order Books Online, Shop By Course.
 - Find the prefix and number of the course you will take. Listed here you will find required and recommended textbook information as well as directions for ordering on-line.
 - Independent studies are governed by Stratford Policy 300-108 that is available in your dean's office. Regularly offered classes will not be provided via Independent Study. The only exception is for a class needed for graduation in the final quarter of the student's university attendance.
- ** Make-up classes will be held.
