

Student & Alumni Ambassador Program

Program Overview

The Student & Alumni Ambassador Program is an honorary group of students and alumni who will represent the university at special events on campus and in the community, as well as online in social media. Ambassadors get connected to and serve local campuses. They seek to enhance prospective students' knowledge about the various student support services and programs offered at Stratford. Students and alumni will demonstrate leadership potential, commitment to community involvement and service, excellent communication skills and high academic standards. The Student Services Manager will be the point of contact for Ambassadors at each campus.

Requirements

Anyone wishing to become a Student & Alumni Ambassador must meet the following requirements to apply:

- Students must maintain a 2.67 GPA for undergraduates and 3.25 GPA for graduate students
- Students must have completed at least 13.5 credit hours
- Students and Alumni must submit an Ambassador application
- Students and Alumni must be recommended by a Stratford University faculty or staff member

Student Benefits

Those who serve as Stratford University Student & Alumni Ambassadors receive many benefits for their service to the college.

- Leadership and mentorship opportunities
- A résumé-building experience
- Professional development opportunities
- Official Stratford University Ambassador name tag
- Certificate of appreciation signed by the university president
- Opportunity to earn points redeemable for Stratford merchandise

Ambassador Responsibilities

Student & Alumni Ambassadors share their Stratford experiences with prospective students, university partners and community members. Common responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Visiting high schools
- Attending college fairs
- Helping at information sessions on campus
- Conducting campus tours
- Participating in new student orientation, registration and commencement
- Assisting at various campus events
