

Stratford University Extra Rewards credit program- Terms and Conditions

Eligible Student:

Only students enrolled in an undergraduate program leading to an AAS degree or a Bachelor's degree are eligible to participate in the Stratford University Extra Rewards credit program

Amount:

The earning rate of the Stratford University Extra Rewards credit program is \$166.50 per class completed at Stratford University after enrollment in the program subject to all applicable program terms and conditions. The maximum amount of the award a recipient can receive is \$3,330.00 for an AAS degree and \$6,660.00 for a Bachelor's degree. Students completing more than 1 degree at either the AAS degree level or the Bachelor's degree level will only be eligible for the maximum earnings at that level for one degree. Students matriculating from an AAS program to a Bachelors program will only be eligible for the maximum amount of the Bachelors program on completion of the bachelors program

Other Terms and Conditions

For a course to count toward earning Stratford University Extra Rewards credit, you must achieve a 2.50 Term GPA, successfully complete the term with a minimum of two (2) enrolled courses, and be in satisfactory academic standing for that term as it relates to Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) and rate of Progress.(ROP). (See catalog for details).

Student will not be eligible for participation in the Stratford University Extra Rewards program if they transfer in more than fifty percent (50%) of the academic credits needed to complete their program of study. Additionally students will only earn Stratford University Extra Rewards credits for classes completed at Stratford University and are part of an eligible program of study.

Stratford University Extra Rewards Credits are only available on a "going forward" basis – assuming all other requirement for program enrollments are met. Points will not be rewarded retroactive to the effective date and quarter of signing up for the Stratford University Extra Rewards Program.

Earned Stratford University Extra Reward credits will automatically be applied to the final term of your qualifying degree program, at the time of graduation. Students may not earn Stratford University Extra Reward Credits in excess of the cost of the remainder of their program. (No residual funds in the form of refunds will be given based on the Stratford University Extra Rewards Credits earned).

Stratford University Extra Reward credits do not cover hard copy books, fees, or past-due balances. They are not transferable or redeemable for cash.

Participation in Stratford University Smart Borrowing Program (see SA office for details) is a requirement for students to qualify for Stratford University Extra Reward credits. For all participating students, any refunds issued after 2016-Q3 that is attributable to Title IV disbursement would be deemed to be non-participation in Stratford University Smart Borrowing Program and will make student ineligible for Stratford University Extra Reward credits earned or ineligible for future participation in the program. Unsubsidized, Subsidized and Plus loan disbursements are considered Title IV loan disbursements for the purpose of this program.

Stratford University Extra Rewards is, in part, a needs-based program, and therefore Stratford University Extra Rewards will be capped at out of pocket tuition payments only, up to the maximum award for the respective degree program. Out of pocket tuition payments include payment plan payments or loans needed to cover tuition and fees. Out of pocket payments do not include grants, scholarships, or other third party payments and reimbursements

Student must remain continuously enrolled and progressing toward their program completion; however, a student may take one (1) Standard Term of Non-Attendance (STNA) per academic year or a break in enrollment not to exceed 1 academic year (3 consecutive terms). (STNA regulations are defined in the Stratford University Catalog). If the student does not return from an STNA, or does not return to active enrollment after 1 academic year, or otherwise withdraw from the university, the student will forfeit Stratford University Extra Rewards earned including all previously earned reward credits and will not be eligible for future participation in the program.

Stratford University Extra Rewards may not be combined with any other tuition discounts provided by Stratford University (such as through education agreements or active duty military). A student receiving other Stratford University tuition discounts is ineligible for participation in the Stratford University Extra Rewards program

Stratford University Extra Reward credits do not cover hard copy books, fees, or past-due balances. They are not transferable or redeemable for cash.*

All Stratford Rewards applications are subject to review for eligibility requirements and must be approved by the University Administration Scholarship Committee. The decision of the University Administration Scholarship Committee shall be final.
